Know ye. That *John Falconer assignee of Andrew Dexter*

having deposited in the **General Land Office**, a Certificate of the Register of the **Land Office** at *Cahaba* whereby it appears that full payment has been made for *the South West quarter of section Seven, in Township sixteen, of Range Eighteen, containing one hundred and sixty acres and sixty eight hundredths of an acre,*

of the lands directed to be sold at *Cahaba* in pursuance of the Laws providing for the sale of the Lands of the **United States** in Mississippi and Alabama: **There is granted**, by the United States, unto the said *John Falconer* the *quarter* lot or section of Land above described: **To have and to hold** the said *quarter* lot or section of land, with the Appurtenances, unto the said *John Falconer* his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof, I have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land-Office to be hereunto affixed.
